Instruction to candidates

1. The examination will be held in accordance with the schedule enclosed herewith
2. The candidate are required to familiarize themselves with the instructions contained herein, particularly the date, time and place of examination.
3. Admission to the Examination hall will be on the production of the admit card which is issued to every candidates
4. The examination hall will be opened half an hour before the start of examination.
5. Every candidate must occupy his seat at the examination hall at least 10 minutes before the time fixed for distribution of the examination paper
6. The candidate will not be allowed to sit in the exam if he/she is late by half an hour.
7. No candidates will be allowed to leave the examination hall before half time.
8. No candidate will be allowed to re-enter the examination hall after he leaves it and submits his/her answer book.
9. Each candidate is allowed a seat bearing his roll number which he must find him/herself and occupy
10. Each candidate must sign his/her name as and when required by the invigilator.
11. Candidates are advised to bring their own pen, pencil, scale, blotting paper and stationary etc., for use and abstain from borrowing these things from their colleagues.
12. Answer book will be supplied to the candidates which must be used to write answer only. Any identification mark on the answer book is forbidden and is liable to disqualify the candidate in case such marks are made by him
13. No candidate is allowed to tear of any page for the answer book.
14. Candidates are required to write their name, roll numbers and other particulars on the slip attached with the answer book.
15. Candidates are not allowed to write anything on the question paper, blotting paper and any other paper carried by them, but shall use a separate page of the answer book for the calculations.
16. Candidates are prohibited to carry during the examination any book, notes, papers, writing scribbling or any other material except the admit card. Candidates are required to deposit these articles with the invigilator or supervisor in-charge at the examination hall
